PROJECT SAVE: SUPERVISORS IN ACTION FOR
VALUES EDUCATION

1. The Philippine Normal University in coordination with the Department of Education, Culture and Sports will conduct a three-day update and tactical planning for DECS regional and division supervisors in Values Education on November 24-26, 1997 at the Philippine Normal University, Taft Avenue, Manila.

2. The objectives of the planning seminar are as follows:

- a. to get updated with the current developments in Values Education;
- b. to be oriented with the VMG of the Values Education Program, its 3-year development plan and the objectives of the Project SAVE;
- c. to organize the Supervisors Association for Values Education (SAVE) and explore the possibility of a DECS-based values organization; and
- d. to develop specific Tactical Plans for the attainment of the objectives of Project SAVE at the regional/division level based on the 3-year development plan.


