PROGRAM OF INSTRUCTION FOR THE SEA SCOUTING TRAINING


**TO : Regional Directors

1. Pursuant to the Memorandum of Agreement entered into by and among the Department of Education, Culture and Sports, Boy Scouts of the Philippines, Philippine Coast Guard and the Philippine Coast Guard Auxillary and in line with the tenor of DECS Memorandum No. 475, s. 1996, entitled "Mobilizing Support for the Sea Scouting Program", this is to remind all concerned personnel of the implementation of the Sea Scouting Program.
2. In this connection, we are furnishing you a copy of the approved Program of Instruction for the conduct of the Sea Scouting Training, including the list of Philippine Coast Guard stations all over the country for your reference.
3. Please coordinate with your local Scout Councils and respective local Coast Guard stations in your area for the proper implementation of the training program. The active participation of all qualified senior scouts in the training is hereby encouraged.
4. This program is very timely in the wake of local and international disasters and emergencies we face today. For this reason, all concerned are hereby directed to support the Sea Scouting Program and all its activities.

All Schools Superintendents are required to submit a report on the coordination done with the Local Scout Councils and Local Coast Guard in this regard, including all activities conducted so far in the implementation of the Sea Scouting Program to the DECS Youth Task Force, Office of the Secretary, UL Complex, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City as soon as coordination and training are completed.

SUBJECT : **PROGRAM OF INSTRUCTION (POI) - SEA SCOUTING
TRAINING**

1. Further to our Memorandum No. 2 dated 14 January 1997, we are furnishing you a copy of the approved Program of Instruction for the conduct of Sea Scouting Training for our qualified Senior Scouts.
2. Coordination should be made through your respective local Coast Guard stations in your area which has the sole responsibility of providing the necessary personnel/trainers and the equipment to be used for the conduct of the training. The DECS Divisions and the local councils shall provide PCG stations the list of qualified Scouts and are encouraged to seek assistance from their local government entities and other private sectors for the proper funding of the course.
3. Attached is the list of Philippine Coast Guard stations all over the country for your reference. Local Councils are required to report to the National Office on the developments of the above program.
4. Immediate implementation of this training is highly expected.

**SEA SCOUTS
(PROGRAM OF INSTRUCTION)**

1. FIRST AID - Minor Wounds, Fractures, Injury, Heart Stroke, Exhaustion, CPR, Mouth to Mouth

At the end of this session, the participant should be able to:

- a. recognize injuries and other bodily harm;
- b. supply temporary relief while waiting for qualified medical personnel on:
 - minor wounds
 - fractures
 - food poisoning
 - heat stroke/exhaustion

Duration: Lecture - 4 hours; Practicum - 4 hours

2. SURVIVAL SWIMMING - Personal Survival, Lifesaving Equipment

At the end of this session, the participant should be able to:

- a. survive in the water with minimal knowledge in scientific swimming;
- b. save other's lives with the use of lifesaving equipment;
- c. be familiar with the use of lifesaving equipment such as lifejackets and liferings

Duration: Lecture - 2 hours; Practicum - 6 hours

3. INTRO TO COAST GUARD FUNCTIONS - Definition of MARSAR, MARSAR, and MAREP; Importance of Boating Safety; Results of Compromise of Maritime Safety

At the end of this session, the participant should be able to:

- a. define maritime safety;
- b. understand the importance of maritime safety;
- c. comprehend safety of life at sea;
- d. identify boating safety risk;
- e. visualize effects of compromise of maritime safety on:
lives/properties/environment

Duration: Lecture - 4 hours

4. SEARCH AND RESCUE ASSISTANCE - Reporting of Maritime Accidents; Reporting of Possible SAR Cases; Handling of Survivors

At the end of this session, the participant should be able to:

- a. Identify a potential SAR SITUATION;
- b. know-how, to whom and when to report in case of sea accidents;
- c. understand common physical state of survivors;
- d. Identify needed supplies and materials in handling survivors;
- e. render appropriate attention to survivors.

Duration: Lecture - 4 hours

**5. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ASSISTANCE - Sources of Pollution:
Ships and Land-Based; Identification of Oil Slick/Spill; Reporting of
Oil Slick/Spill**

At the end of this session, the participant should be able to:

- a. understand pollution;
- b. identify sources & causes of pollution (Ships or land-based);
- c. Identify manifestations of pollution (oil spill/garbage);
- d. know-how, to whom and what to report in case of pollution incidents;
- e. conduct simple methods of clean-up.

Duration: Lecture - 4 hours; Practicum - 4 hours

6. PRACTICAL EXERCISE

At the end of this session, the participant should be able to:

- a. appropriately handle survivors;
- b. apply first aid;
- c. identify pollution incidents;
- d. perform simple oil pollution clean-up operations.

Duration: Practicum - 8 hours
