
1997 UNITED NATIONS WEEK OBSERVANCE

To: Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Heads of Private Elementary and Secondary Schools

1. The United Nations Association of the Philippines, in cooperation with the United Nations Information Centre, UNECSO and the Department of Education, Culture and Sports, will coordinate the 1997 United Nations Week Observance on October 17-24.
2. The theme for this year's observance is "Eradication of Poverty is an Ethical, Social, Political, Moral and Imperative of Humankind."
3. The period 1997-2000 was declared as the first United Nations Decade for the Eradication of Poverty. In this connection, it is suggested that activities concerning the celebration should be guided by the principles and standards related to the theme through the guidance of the teacher.

Theme: Eradication of Poverty is an ethical, social, political, moral, and imperative to humankind.

Suggested Activities:

1. Discuss and explain the meaning of poverty.
2. Identify or find out the causes of poverty in each respective locality.
3. Find out the causes of poverty on the following categories such as: economic, geographical, political, social, psychological, cultural, and so on.
4. Explain some possible solutions on how to eradicate poverty existing in a particular community.
5. Create or write poetry or short stories on how to help solve poverty existing in a particular community.
6. Write short stories to help solve simple poverty in a community.
7. Paint, draw, or create multi-dimensional art work.
8. Organize a debate or oratorical on concepts related to the theme.
9. Prepare exhibits of the student's finished art work and other activities.
10. Organize a parade and/or a convocation program as a culminating activity of the UN Week and invite the parents and resource persons to talk about the concept on how to eradicate poverty for the future generation.
