39th ANNUAL NATIONAL CONVENTION OF CMLI JUNIOR MEMBERS AND TEACHER-ADVISERS

- 1. The Children's Museum and Library Inc. (CMLI), in coordination with this Department, announces the conduct of its 39th Annual National Convention of Junior Members and Teacher-Advisers at Teachers' Camp, Baguio City from October 26 to 31.
- 2. The Convention will revolve on the theme "The Youth's Perspective in Strengthening Respect for Human Rights Towards the Promotion of National Growth." This week-long convention aims to increase the awareness of the youth on certain socio-economic developments in their communities and in other places. Activities will include workshops/commission discussions and group dynamic sessions featuring modules on leadership-training, values formation, interpersonal relation and communication. Contests to showcase individual talents and collective endeavors, sportsfest and socials will also be conducted.
- 3. Authorized to participate in the convention are bonafide and outstanding high school students from both public and private schools nationwide. He/she must satisfy at least, one of the following requirements: a member of the honor roll, an officer of the school council, an editor of the school paper, or head of any school/or community-based-organization.
- 4. A conference fee of three thousand five hundred pesos (P3,500.00) will be charged each student-participant and each teacher-delegate to cover expenses for board and lodging, conference materials, souvenir program and other training expenses. Transportation allowance of participants may be charged against school funds or the sponsoring agencies/organizations.

- 5. Student delegates will undergo make-up classes to cover lessons missed for one week. Schedule of activities and the conference guidelines are inclosed. Those interested must make their reservations on or before October 17, 1997 at the CMLI Secretariat Unit 7, Fersal Condominium II, 130 Kalayaan Avenue, Diliman, Quezon City, Tel. nos. 924-23 -04/924-22 -97, Fax: (632) 924-22-97.

GUIDELINES

- 1. ELIGIBILITY: The conference is open to students of public and private secondary schools nationwide. Schools are advised to send their top students consisting of student council, school paper editors, members of the honor roll and officers of their school organizations. Aside from leadership and academic qualifications, each delegate must be of good moral character and good physical health.
- 2. CONFERENCE FEE: The conference fee for this week-long activity is THREE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (P 3,500.00) for each student and teacher delegate. This amount/fee is inclusive of board and lodging, conference materials, souvenir program and other training expenses EXCEPT round-trip transportation to the conference venue.
- 3. DEADLINE: Those interested must make their reservations on or before October 17, at the CMLI Secretariat located at Unit 7, Fersal Condominium II, 130 Kalayaan Avenue, Diliman, Quezon City with telephone nos. (FAXPhone) 924-2304 and 924-2297. A reservation is honored only upon payment of non-refundable deposit of, at least, fifty percent (50%) of the conference fee each person. The balance must be paid during the registration on October 26, 1997.
- 4. PRE-REGISTRATION: A reservation is honored only upon sending of the reply form with the final list and number of participating delegates. Participants who wish to join the convention must go through this pre-registration activity on or before the deadline. Failure to comply with this would make a non-reservation of your slot in the convention because registration during the convention would only be open to those who are pre-registered.
- 5. ATTIRE: Delegates are required to wear a mal attire during the opening and closing ceremonies. Since sports activities will be held, appropriate attire is considering. Please bring enough warm clothing considering the cool weather of Baguio City.
- 6. ACCOMMODATIONS FOR THE CONVENTION: The Teachers' Camp shall provide complete bedding including one blanket and one pillow per person. Delegates are advised to bring additional blankets and pillow if they wish.
- 7. JUNIOR COUNCIL ELECTIONS: Those interested to run for the Junior Council National Executive Board should bring a letter of permission from their parents. This letter should indicate that the student is allowed by his/her parents to the responsibilities of an officer for one year term until the next annual convention. This shall be include regular attendance of meetings which are once or twice in two weeks, and all activities of the CMLI.

LIST OF ACTIVITIES

- 1. COMMISSION DISCUSSIONS: Delegates are grouped into different commission to engage in group dynamic sessions. Various topics related to the theme will be discussed. Leadership-training, values formation and personal interaction modules will be prepared for the benefit of the delegates.
- 2. CONTESTS: There shall be a Literary-Musical (LITMUS) contest by commissions and the best performing group will be given due recognition. A SPORTSFEST will also be held. Details will be discussed by the blocks/commission during the conference proper.
- 3. TALENT VARIETY SHOW (TVS). A talent valiety show among participating schools shall be held. Interested school delegations must prepare before hand since no time will be given for rehearsals. CMLI reserves the right to screen performers (see schedule of screening). Individual performances are given a maximum of five (5) minutes while group will be given a maximum of ten (10) minutes.
- 4. COMPETITIONS FOR EXCELLENCE: The convention shall have the following contests: poem writing and delivery contest, timpalak dagliang pagsusulat at pagtutula, essay writing contest, timpalak dagliang pagsusulat, extemporaneous public speaking contest, timpalak dagliang talumpatian, and on-the-spot poster making contest. Only one student per delegation is allowed to participate in each contest. Contestants for the poster making should bring their own art materials.
- 5. MOTIF NIGHT: The motif night to be worn, during this event should be agreed upon by early delegation. However, decency of the dress code should be considered. Since this will be a competition among schools, delegates are requested to be in their best attire.
- 6. 4TH ANNUAL CMLI NATIONAL INTER-SCHOO! DEBATE: The Championship phase of the CMLI Inter-School Debate will be held within the conference period. The debate is one; to all public and private secondary schools nationwide. If you have not yet receive the debate coldelines yet, please call the CMLI Secretariat.


