**THE 1998 NATIONAL ACADEMY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY (NAST)
SEARCH FOR OUTSTANDING ACHIEVEMENTS IN SCIENCE AND
TECHNOLOGY**

1. The National Academy of Science and Technology (NAST) of the Department of Science and Technology (DOST), in cooperation with the Department of Education, Culture and Sports (DECS), is announcing the 1998 Search for Outstanding Achievements in Science and Technology.
2. The Search aims to give recognition to outstanding achievements in science and technology as well as provide meaningful incentives to those engaged in scientific and technological research.
3. The awards are as follows:
 - 3.1 **Outstanding Young Scientist (OYS) Awards.** These awards are given to young Filipino scientists who have made significant contributions to science and technology.
 - 3.2 **NAST-TWAS Science Prize.** The NAST-TWAS Science Prize is an award given by the NAST and the Third World Academy of Sciences (TWAS) to an outstanding young scientist in the field of Biology.
 - 3.3 **Philippine Talent Search for Young Scientists.** The award is given to encourage young people to pursue a career in science and is presented to scientists who excel in science or technology study.

4. Nominations for these awards may be made by heads of government and private research institutions, departments of colleges and universities, and academic or professional scientific organizations or societies. Details and sample nomination forms are inclosed for information and guidance.

**OUTSTANDING
YOUNG SCIENTIST AWARDS**

The Outstanding Young Scientist (OYS) Awards are given to young Filipino scientists (less than 40 years old) who have made significant contributions to science and technology.

Ten (10) OYS Awards are available annually in the following divisions:

- Mathematical, Physical and Engineering Sciences
- Biological Sciences
- Social Sciences
- Agricultural Sciences
- Medical Sciences

The Award consists of a trophy and cash.

A nominee must be:

- a. A Filipino citizen;
- b. 40 years old or younger on the day of the awarding during the National Science and Technology Week (the 2nd week of July);
- c. must have demonstrated an exceptional ability to undertake scientific research as evidenced by papers published in reputable scientific journals; and
- d. must have good moral character.

Judging is based on:

- a. Quality and number of scientific work and publications.
- b. Contributions to the advances of science in general and to science in the Philippines, in particular, and
- c. Contribution to the well-being of the Philippine economy and culture.

NAST-TWAS SCIENCE PRIZE

The NAST-TWAS Science Prize is an Award given to an outstanding young Filipino scientist by the Academy (NAST) and the Third World Academy of Sciences (TWAS).

One award each year, consisting of US\$2,000 and a plaque, is given in the selected discipline for the year - biology or chemistry, or mathematics, or physics.

For 1998, the NAST-TWAS Science Prize will be given for Biology. For 1999, 2000 and 2001, it will be for Chemistry, Mathematics, and Physics, respectively.

- A nominee must be:
 - a. A Filipino citizen;
 - b. 40 years old or younger on the day of awarding which is scheduled during the 2nd week of July;
 - c. of good moral character;
 - d. possessing at least a master of science or Ph.D. degree;
 - e. author or coauthor of a significant number of original research publications; and
 - f. fully qualified for an OYS award.

Criteria for selection include:

- a. Quality and number of scientific work and publications,
- b. Contributions to the advances of science in general and to science in the Philippines, in particular, and
- c. Contribution to the well-being of the Philippine economy and culture

The Philippine Talent Search for Young Scientists is a project of NAST to encourage young people to pursue a career in science.

Prizes will be awarded to the best three scientific paper presenters plus P25,000 for First Prize, P15,000 for Second Prize and P10,000 for Third Prize. The paper may be in any field of science, basic or applied.

Candidates nominated must be:

- Filipino citizens
- 25 years old or younger at the time of the awarding scheduled on the 2nd week of July of each year;
- students or graduate of sciences;
- of good moral character;
- affiliated with any of the following:
 1. scientific society (academic or professional)
 2. research institution (firm, government or private)
 3. college/university;
- presentation of a scientific paper (published or unpublished) during a Science Congress to be scheduled. The involvement of the nominee in the research should be explained if the paper is jointly authored.

Nominations for these awards may be made by heads of Government or private research institutions, departments of Colleges and Universities, academic or professional scientific organizations or societies.

The deadline for submission of nominations is the last working day of November of each year.
