DECS CENTENNIAL RADIO COMPETITION
MAGKAKATALO SA TALINO

1. To fully celebrate the Centennial of Philippine Independence, the Department of Education, Culture and Sports and the Aliw Broadcasting Corporation are jointly conducting the **1998 DECS -DWIZ CENTENNIAL RADIO COMPETITION ON THE MAGKAKATALO SA TALINO** in the **BACK TO THE BASICS RADIO** Program aired at station DWIZ from 5:00 - 6:30 in the afternoon every Saturday from February 7, 1998 to June 12, 1998.

2. The contest is open to all Grade V and VI elementary school pupils from any public or private schools. Every Saturday, the best participants consisting of two pupils from the private school and two pupils from the public school shall represent each school division scheduled to compete at the 5th floor Dominga Bldg. where the radio station studio of DWIZ is located, at the corner of dela Rosa St. and Pasong Tamo, Makati City. Each team will be accompanied by their respective school coaches and the Regional HEKASI supervisor at the regional and national levels. The radio competition which will be conducted live shall cover the following areas: Philippine History, Philippine Geography and National Centennial of Philippine Independence. References may include the elementary instructional materials, elementary HEKASI books, the Kalayaan newspaper and others.

3. The implementing guidelines of this Centennial Radio competition is in inclosure 2.0 of this Memorandum for the information and guidance of all concerned.

4. The cost of travel (to and from the contest venue) and other expenses incidental to their participation in the contest of the four (4) pupils, two (2) coaches and one (1) HEKASI supervisor shall be chargeable against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules. In addition the Local School Board funds and/or local government officials may be tapped as sponsors to help cover the expenses in the participation at the regional and national levels.


5. Prizes listed in the attached inclosure 1.0 are donated by the Aliw Broadcasting Corporation, this Department and other sponsors. Additional prizes will be announced over the Radio DWIZ as necessary.

6. For the Cluster B, C and D groups, School Division Superintendent are enjoined to identify their best contestants to represent their School Division either by conducting their own division contests or by process of elimination. The Division winners shall compete at the Regional level. While the Regional levels winner shall represent their regions at the Cluster Competition. The Cluster winners shall represent their group at the National Grand Final competition level on June 12, 1998.

7. For the proper guidance of all concerned it is desired that the names, school, ages and addresses of the contestants shall be submitted to this office (attn. Dr. Ma. Lourdes V. Macatangay) Tel No. 636 48-78 or sent by FAX 633-72-64) at least two weeks before their scheduled regional and Cluster Competition.

8. In view of the importance of this activity in enhancing the knowledge and appreciation among our youth of the values of the Centennial of the Philippine Independence, all Regional Directors and School Division Superintendents are enjoined to give their full support to the success of this project.

9. Wide dissemination of the contents of this Memorandum is desired.
