1998 NATIONAL TRAINING PROGRAM FOR SCHOOL PAPER ADVISERS



1. The yearly National Training Program for School Paper Advisers which is mandated in R.A. 7079 dated July 5, 1991 otherwise known as the Campus Journalism Act shall be held at the Junior Mess, Teachers Camp, Baguio City from April 22-24, 1998.
2. The theme of the training program is: "School Paper Management in the Centennial of Philippine Independence".
3. The training program aims to:
 - o update the school paper advisers on trends in school paper management;
 - o utilize the school paper management as an effective avenue for creating awareness and promoting the significance of the Centennial of Philippine Independence; and
 - o provide an appropriate forum for a healthy exchange of ideas/experiences in school paper management.
4. The participants in the summer training program are:
 - o 30 school paper advisers per region (15 elementary and 15 secondary)
 - o 28 members of the Executive and Working Committees
 - o 50 officers of the National Elementary and Secondary School Paper Associations
 - o 16 Outstanding School Paper Advisers for SY 1997-98
 - o 10 resource persons
 - o 16 regional supervisors in-charge of journalism

5. Transportation and other travel expenses of participants relative to this Training Program shall be charged against local funds subject to availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. However, the same expenses of the members of the executive committee, over-all coordinators, chairpersons and members of the working committees from Manila to Baguio City and back to Manila as well as board and lodging for all participants, workshop materials and honoraria shall be charged against journalism funds as provided for in R.A. No. 7079, also subject to accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

6. The Guidelines to be considered in the choice of the participants, the composition of the Executive and Working Committees and the 1998 elected officers of the National Elementary and Secondary School Paper Associations are contained in Appendix A of this Memorandum.

7. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

GUIDELINES ON THE CHOICE OF PARTICIPANTS TO THE 1998 NATIONAL TRAINING PROGRAM FOR SCHOOL PAPER ADVISERS

1. The total number of participants for the training program shall not be more than six hundred (600).
2. The Regional School Paper Advisers' Association (elementary and secondary) shall select the 15 elementary and 15 secondary level participants to make up 30.
3. Teacher-advisers who have the potential to serve as regional trainers as well as experienced advisers who have had the opportunity to act as trainers shall be the priority in the selection of the participants.
4. The sixteen (16) regional supervisors (English or Filipino) in-charge of journalism shall be chosen by the Secondary Education Chiefs.
5. The list of participants shall be submitted to the DECS RO for approval on or before March 10, 1998. Subsequently, the approved list shall be submitted to the Bureau of Secondary Education, Attn.: Mr. Lamberto M. Gabriel or Mrs. Lynn M. Villamin, U.L. Complex, Meralco Ave., Pasig City not later than March 20, 1998.
