DECS - NMYL AWARDS OF EXCELLENCE

**TO : Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents**

1. **Background.** The Department of Education, Culture and Sports (DECS) and the National Movement of Young Legislators (NMYL) signed a Memorandum of Agreement expressing joint support and collaboration for the DECS - NMYL Awards of Excellence and the establishment of the "Schools of the Future" during the 6th NMYL National Congress held last February 2-4, 1997 in Davao City. The DECS - NMYL Awards of Excellence, now on its second year, is an annual program which seeks to give recognition to the outstanding academic and co-curricular achievements of graduating students in the various school levels.
2. **Objectives.** The DECS - NMYL Awards of Excellence seeks to achieve the following objectives :
 - a. To mobilize both the DECS and NMYL local officers and members to cooperate with each other towards the attainment of educational excellence, cultural development and sports participation;
 - b. To select exemplary leaders and achievers among graduating students in the secondary level who have acquired outstanding academic and co-curricular achievements.
 - c. To mobilize resources, financial or otherwise, in support for outstanding young achievers; and
 - d. To mobilize local government resources in extending support and incentives for budding youth leaders and achievers in the locality.

3. **Qualifications.** The awardee should acquire the following qualifications :

a. He/She must be an exemplary student (valedictorian).

b. In case of a tie, or more than one qualifies for the award, the awardee should, aside from his/her academic credentials, excel in co-curricular activities, whether in the field of culture, arts, music or sports, among others.

4. **Selection and Awarding.** Upon receipt of this Memorandum, the Division Superintendent or his/her authorized representative shall coordinate with the local NMYL officers and members. A memorandum issued by the NMYL shall also be sent to the local NMYL officers and members informing them about the coordination needed for the total success of the project (see annex A).

Upon determining one (1) awardee in each secondary school within the Division, the Division Superintendent shall send, as soon as possible, the list of all the names of the awardees, including their one-page profile/bio-data and preferably with photo, principals, schools and addresses of the same for the distribution of the certificates and for all necessary coordination to :

The awarding ceremony shall be conducted preferably during the graduation exercises of the particular school.

During the ceremonies, a uniform statement stating the background, nature and relevance of the program, including the major sponsors shall be read by the award presenter. (see Annex B)

5. **Certificates and Medals.** Duly signed certificates shall be provided the Division Superintendent by the Office of the Secretary. Receipt of the same shall be acknowledged by the Division Superintendent to be forwarded to the office above-indicated.

Either the Division Superintendent or the NMYL Local Official/Coordinator or both shall sign the certificate on the space provided for.

Medals may be provided by the local NMYL officers or members. Ideally, medals should conform with the official DECS-NMYL Award of Excellence Medal design herein attached. (see Annex C)


6. **Monitoring and Evaluation.** During its implementation, representatives of the DECS and NMYL shall closely monitor the conduct of the program through regular visitations.

A post-activity evaluation shall also be conducted. A uniform evaluation sheet shall be filled up by the Division Superintendent and/or the NMYL local Official/Coordinator to provide feedback regarding the activity. (see Annex D)

7. **Program Partner.** The National Movement of Young Legislators, referred to as the NMYL, with address at NMYL National Office Unit 1, 2nd Floor, Francisco Gold Condominium, 784 EDSA, West Kamias, Quezon City, is represented by Vice Governor EDGAR M. CHATTO.

The NMYL is the biggest nationwide league of young local government officials, composed of Vice Governors, Provincial Board Members, Vice Mayors, Councilors and Sangguniang Kabataan Federation Presidents, which works for the advancement of programs and services of its members.

8. **Other Matters.** All Bureau Directors, Regional Directors and Schools Superintendents are encouraged to support this program and the partnership which the DECS and the NMYL envision to achieve.

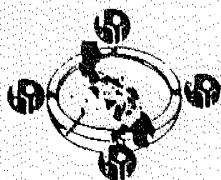


Either one or both the Division Superintendent and the NMYL (local coordinator) shall sign the certificate on the space provided for.
