1998 SUMMER TRAINING PROGRAMS IN SPECIAL EDUCATION

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. The Bureau of Elementary Education in coordination with non-government agencies is sponsoring training programs in Special Education in Summer 1998 at the following institutions:

- a. Philippine Normal University, Taft Avenue, Manila, "Training Program for Teachers of the Visually Impaired", April 13 to May 8, 1998
- b. YMCA Open College, Manila, "Training Program for Teachers of the Hearing Impaired", April 13 to May 8, 1998

The training program for the teachers of the visually impaired will be funded by the Resources for the Blind, Inc. (RBI), 623 EDSA, Quezon City while the training program for the hearing impaired will be funded by Christoffel Blindenmission (CBM), Alabang, Muntinlupa City.

2. These training programs aim to upgrade competencies of teachers in providing educational services appropriate to children with visual or hearing impairment.

3. Suggested priority regions/divisions/districts/schools where the batch of nominees should come from are listed in Inclosure No. I A & B. Applicants shall be screened by the existing Regional Integrated Scholarship Committee based on the criteria set in Inclosure No. 2. Selected applicants for the visually impaired should make a collect call to Mr. Randy Weisser, Resources for the Blind, Tel. No. 726-30-21 for the interview on or before March 13, 1998. Deadline for the submission of nominees to the Region is on

February 27, 1998. The list of nominees shall be forwarded to the Special Education Division, Bureau of Elementary Education not later than the last week of March. The selected nominees shall be advised to submit all the document listed in Inclosure Nos. 2 and 3 to the Special Education Division, Bureau of Elementary Education on April 13, 1998, before the orientation.

4. Teachers who were recipients of the DECS-RBI-PNU Summer Training Program in 1996 and 1997 and DECS-CBM-YMCA Summer Training in 1997 are listed in Inclosure No. 4A, B and C. Only those teachers who are actually providing educational services to the visually or hearing impaired will be given the opportunity to continue their training in Summer 1998.

5. Grantees under the two training program outside NCR shall be entitled to free tuition fees and a monthly stipend of two thousand pesos (P2,000.00). Their traveling expenses to and from Manila shall be borne by the sponsoring agencies. They are advised to travel by sea or land. For the trainees in NCR, they are entitled to free tuition fees and a monthly stipend of one thousand pesos (P1,000.00).

6. State colleges and universities as well as private institutions interested in offering undergraduate and graduate course in special education or in providing services to children with special needs are encouraged to send their nominees directly to the special Education Division, Bureau of Elementary Education, DECS Complex, Pasig City with the required documents. Expenses for the training shall be charged to their own local funds. A teacher who will be joining the training shall be charged an amount of Two Thousand Eight Hundred Seventy Five Pesos (P2,875.00) for the tuition fee. For the training on Visual Impairment, the amount shall be paid in cash to RBI while the amount for the training on Hearing Impairment shall also be paid in cash to CBM.

7. Immediate dissemination of the contents of this Memorandum is desired.

1. Is a Bachelor's degree holder.
2. Has permanent status for at least three (3) years with Very Satisfactory performance
3. Is actually teaching classes at the elementary or secondary level.
4. Has grade point average of 2.0/85 in the undergraduate/graduate/post graduate study.
5. Is not more than 45 years.
6. If married, is not pregnant nor a nursing mother.
7. Has no administrative/criminal record.
8. Is physically fit, mentally healthy and register positive attitude and commitment toward work, peers and students.
9. Is willing to conduct and/or assist in in-service training activities after scholarship.
10. Is willing to defray own expenses in case of delay of stipend/reimbursement of travel expenses.
11. Has not availed of any scholarship program for the past three (3) years.
12. Can adequately communicate in both English and Filipino.

1. Complete Form 212 (Personal Data Sheet), including Performance Appraisal Rating for the past three (3) rating periods
2. Certified true copy of Transcript of Records

4. Certification from Head Office (Principal/Superintendent/Chief of Elementary Education Division) that the nominee is actually teaching and recommending him/her for scholarship duly endorsed by the Superintendent and Regional Director.

4. Submit to the Bureau of Elementary Education at the end of the training a copy of his/her action plan;

5. Immediately report to his/her station and assume his/her functions upon the completion or termination of his/her training;

6. Organize SPED programs or classes for the hearing/visually impaired;

7. Shall serve his/her school/agency for at least two (2) years after each summer training;

8. Shall refund in full to his/her school/agency and to Christoffel Blindenmission or the Resources for the Blind, Inc., such sums of money as may have been defrayed by the Philippine government and/or sponsor if he/she fails to provide educational services to the hearing/visually impaired for at least two (2) years after each summer training; and

9. Shall live up to the terms and conditions of this grant.
