
DECS MEMORANDUM No. 77, s. 1998

NATIONAL SYMPOSIUM ON "HISTORY MAKES WOMEN, WOMEN MAKE HERSTORY"

- 1. The National Centennial Commission Women Sector with co-sponsors University of the Philippines, Philippine Women's University-DIWA and the Women's Studies Association of the Philippines in coordination with the Department of Education, Culture and Sports, will hold a two-day National Symposium on the theme: "History Makes Women, Women Make Herstory" on March 9-10, 1998 at the Bahay ng Alumni, University of the Philippines, Diliman, Quezon City from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
- 2. The objective of the symposium is to make Filipino women visible in recorded history and explore various feminist research methodologies and modes of writing in the weaving of Philippine history. Inclosed is the schedule of activities of the symposium.
- 3. Teachers, supervisors, administrators and guidance counselors of both public and private schools are encouraged to attend as participants.
- 4. Teachers, supervisors, administrators, and guidance counselors of public schools as well as DECS-OSEC representatives may attend on official time. Expenses for allowances, transportation, and a registration fee of seven hundred pesos (P700.00) shall be charged against local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Private school participants shall make arrangements with their respective institutions.

- 5. Participants can pre-register on or before February 25, 1998 at the Women's Studies Association of the Philippines, University of the Philippines, U.P. Diliman, Quezon City with fax no. 920-6880 from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Confirmation of attendance should be made beforehand to ensure inclusion in the participant's list.
- 6. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned is expected.

- To orient and prepare the participants for the forthcoming international conference in December 1998.


