THIRD PHILIPPINE TEACHERS FOUNDATION, INC. (PTFINC) NATIONAL CONVENTION

- 1. The Philippine Teachers Foundation, Inc. (PTF, Inc.) is holding its 3rd Annual National Convention from April 12-16, 1998 at Teachers Camp, Baguio City with the theme "Striving for Excellence in the Next Millennium."
- 2. The Convention aims to inform and update all concerned on the on-going projects of the Philippine Teachers Foundation, Inc. in relation to the DECS thrust on excellence in Education.
- 3. Participants to the Convention are classroom teachers from the elementary and secondary public and private schools and faculty members from State Colleges and Universities. Attendance to the Convention is under the discretion of the Regional Director and Schools Division Superintendent in relation to the region and division priorities.
- 4. The conference fee of two-thousand five hundred pesos (P2,500.00) to cover board and lodging, conference materials, souvenir programs and certificates will be charged to the participant's personal account.
- 5. Delegates are encouraged to strictly wear formal attire during the opening and closing ceremonies. The wearing of sandos, short shorts and slippers should be confined strictly to the bedroom and the bathroom. Participants are expected to perform during the Talent Night Show (individually) and Cultural Night (by groups) showcasing songs and/or dances emanating from their respective regions. Teachers Camp shall provide complete beddings.
- 6. Registration will start at one o'clock in the afternoon. Those who may come ahead will have to pay for accommodation and for food.
- 7. Participants are advised to make their reservations early at the Philippine Teachers Foundation, Inc. Office at Room D408B, Philippine International Convention Center, Roxas Boulevard, Manila with telephone no. 831-69-09. A reservation is honored only upon payment of a non-refundable deposit of at least fifty percent of the Conference fee per person. The balance must be paid during registration at Teachers Camp in Baguio City on April 12, 1998. The telephone number of the Philippine Teachers' Foundation, Inc. office is 831-69-09.
