**DECS-PHILIPPINES HOSTING AND PARTICIPATION TO THE 22ND
ASEAN SCHOOLS TRACK AND FIELD CHAMPIONSHIPS**

**To: Undersecretaries/Assistant Secretaries
Bureau/Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents**

1. The Philippines, through the Department of Education, Culture and Sports (DECS) is hosting the 22nd ASEAN Schools Track and Field Championships on May 21-24 at Bacolod City with the province of Negros Occidental and the City of Bacolod as co-hosts.
2. The Bureau of Physical Education and Schools Sports (BPSS) shall lead in the preparation, administration and management of the championships. The Bureau shall likewise be responsible in forming and training of the Philippine team. The bases of selection of athletes for the Philippine Team shall be the performance of our athletes in the Palarong Pambansa 1998.
3. Regional Directors and other officials concerned shall arrange for the make-up classes of their qualified athletes, provide them, including coaches, trainers, chaperons and officiating officials with moral, technical and financial supports.
4. Expenses incidental to the preparation, participation and management of the championships shall be charged to BPSS funds and any available sources, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. MILO (Nestle Inc.) shall be the main sponsor of the championships. Participation of other sponsors shall be encouraged to lessen government expenditure.
