# Guidelines on Rainbow '98 International Children's Art Contest

The Gallery of Children's Art invites you to take part on its 11th international competition

#### CONDITIONS

- AGE: 4 17 years
- SUBJECT: The subject of the competition works is freely selected. It would be desirable, if the competitors could present their country's scenery, values, beauty, the life, the happiness and the problems of the family, their school, friends, fellows or anything they deem important in their life.
- TECHNIQUE: The competition works may be made with the use of any
  material and technique of fine art: techniques of graphic and painting,
  sculptures and ceramics; batiks; painted textiles; copper embossing, fired
  enamel, etc.; computer-art; video-art.
- SIZE: The pictures must be not less than 20 x 30 cm and not more than 50 x 70 cm.

Every competitor must send at least two original works made in 1997-98 which have not yet been presented in any competition or exhibition.

# **PRESENTATION**

The following data must be indicated (typed in English or Hungarian language) on the backside or on the bottom of every work

- 1. Full name of the competitor
- 2. Sex
- 3. Age and the date of birth
- 4. Title of the work
- 5-6. Precise address (Both the home and school address)
- 7. The name and the signature of the master who helped (directed) the competitor

The works submitted to the competition should be mailed through the schools, institutions, or organizations with enclosed typed summarized list of contents by the item.

Works which arrive in damaged condition, are not accompanied with correct data required, and/or arrive after the closing date will not accepted.

### NOTE

The submitted works will not be returned. The works qualified by the jury as suitable for exhibition, go into the collection of the Gallery of Children's Art, and will be also used for our publications.

The works with lower qualification go into the collection of Hungarian Art University. The organizers reserve all rights in connection with the submitted works.

#### **EVALUATION OF THE COMPETITION**

The suitability for the exhibitions and the different prizes will be awarded by the jury consisting of artists, art historians, art teachers and specialists of children's works.

**Main Prize**: The most excellent art works in each category of techniques will be awarded plaquettes and diploma certificates.

**Age Group Prize**: Plaquettes and diploma certificates will be awarded to the best performance among competitors by age group.

**Diploma Certificate**: Gold, Silver and Bronze diplomas will be awarded the outstanding art works.

The awarded works will be on display in various towns of Hungary and abroad. The best of competitors will be invited to our art activity camp in Zanka, Hungary.
