20TH CMLI ANNUAL NATIONAL SUMMER CONFERENCE
AND WORKCAMP

1. The Children's Museum and Library Inc. (CMLI), in coordination with this Department, announces the conduct of its 20th CMLI Annual National Summer Conference and Workshop of the Junior Members and Teachers-Advisers at Lucban, Quezon on April 19-25, 1998.
2. The convention will resolve on the theme "New Perspective: The Significance of the Centennial Celebration of Philippine Independence Towards National Progress." This week-long activity aims to increase the awareness of the youth on certain socio-economic developments in their communities and in other places. The main feature of this conference is the Executive Training Seminar (ETS) which will cover Project Feasibility Study (PFS) making, Management by Objectives (MBO), Key Result Area (KRA) highlighted by PFS defense session of and/or school-based projects to be planned and implemented by the participating school delegation themselves, workshops/commission discussions and group dynamic sessions featuring modules on leadership-training and values formation, interpersonal relation and communication. Contests to showcase individual talents and collective endeavors, sportsfest and socials will also be conducted.
3. Participants must be bonafide and outstanding high school students from both public and private schools nationwide. He/she must satisfy at least, one of the following requirements: a member of the honor roll, or an officer of the school council, an editor of the school paper, or head of any school/community-based organization.
4. A conference fee of two thousand nine hundred fifty pesos (P2,950.00) will be charged each student-participant and each member teacher-adviser to cover expenses for board and lodging, conference materials and other training expenses. Those interested must make their reservations on or before April 10 at the CMLI Secretariat, Unit 7, Fersal Condominium 11, 130 Kalayaan Avenue, Diliman, Quezon City with telephone numbers: 924-23-04 (faxphone) and 924-2297. Schedule of activities and conference guidelines are inclosed.
