1. The Private School Health Officers' Association, Incorporated (PSHOA) will hold its 18th Anniversary and 17th Annual Convention on April 22-24, 1998 at the New Bayanihan Hall, United Laboratories Incorporated, Mandaluyong City with this year's theme "*PSHOA, Geared Towards the Turn of the New Millenium*".

2. The objectives of the convention are as follows:

- a. to enable participants/delegates to make a clear definition of the role of school health officers on the challenging problems concerning health and nutrition;
