1998 CENTENNIAL EDUCATORS CONGRESS

- 1. The 1998 Centennial Educators Congress will be held at Teachers Camp, Baguio City on May 25-26, 1998 with the theme "Every Filipino Can Be A Hero".
- 2. This year's activity, which will bring into focus the 100th year of Philippine Independence, will target its discussion on topics like what is heroism, what lessons were learned from the one hundred years of freedom and independence, what made Rizal, Mabini, Bonifacio, etc. heroes, how one defines heroism in the 21st Century and how can one be a hero today.
- 3. This year's Congress will accommodate 641 participants only. At the central office, authorized to attend are undersecretaries, assistant secretaries, bureau directors, assistant directors, heads of units/services and division chiefs. Other participants are regional directors, assistant regional directors, schools superintendents, assistant schools superintendents, chiefs of divisions, parents, heads of private elementary and secondary schools, officials of PASSA, PESPA and PAES and congress committee members. - 4. The conference fee is three thousand two hundred pesos (P3,200.00) to cover board and lodging, materials and conference kit.
- 5. Expenses including conference fees, board and lodging and transportation of participants and committee members from DECS and government schools shall be charged against local/office funds subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Those coming from private institutions shall make financial arrangements with their respective offices.

6. Inclosed are copies of the program of activities and list of participants.

7. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned is desired.
