THE FIRST NPC SCIENCE CAMP FOR TEACHERS


1. The National Power Corporation (NPC), in pursuance to the provisions of Memorandum of Agreement between NPC and DECS signed last June 3, 1996, to uplift and broaden science teaching in secondary schools particularly in areas where NPC power plants operate, will conduct the first Science Camp for Teachers (SCT) at the Calaca Science Centrum (CSC), Batangas Coal-Fired Thermal Power Plant (BCFTPP) Complex, Calaca, Batangas on May 20-22, 1998.
2. The SCT aims to bring science teachers together in a three-day live-in workshop where subject matter experts composed of NPC volunteers will seek to broaden the teachers' knowledge and perspective on power generation, transmission, environment and other related disciplines. The workshop also aims to improve their skills for more effective science teaching.
3. There will be 40 participants to the workshop composed of 25 secondary school teachers from DECS Region IV and one secondary teacher from each of the other 15 regions of DECS preferably in the identified Schools of the Future near existing NPC power plants.
