FIRST INTERNATIONAL KODALY AND DALCROZE  
SEMINAR-WORKSHOP

1. The International Institute for Contemporary Music Studies of the University of Santo Tomas (UST) in coordination with the Department of Education, Culture and Sports, will hold the First International Kodaly and Dalcroze Seminar-Workshop in the Philippines on April 20-26, 1998 at the UST Conservatory of Music, 5<sup>th</sup> Floor, Education Building, Espana, Manila.
2. The seminar aims to:
  - a. increase teachers' awareness of Kodaly methods;
  - b. develop sight reading and conducting skills among the participants;  
and
  - c. provide participants with music playing experiences using the recorder.
3. The seminar-workshop will bring together music leaders, music teachers, and supervisors of both elementary and high schools to share and exchange ideas. The clinicians are internationally well known experts in the field of music education.
4. A registration fee of two thousand five hundred pesos (P2,500.00) will be charged each participant to cover lunches, handouts, certificates, honoraria for speakers and music instructors, chargeable against local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
