

SEMINAR ON CLASSICAL PHYSICS AND ENVIRONMENT

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Schools Superintendents  
Chairman, CHED

1. The Institute for Environment and the Sciences of the College of Arts and Sciences of the University of Asia and the Pacific, in coordination with the Department of Education, Culture and Sports shall conduct a series of 12 half -Saturday Seminar on Classical Physics and Environment starting January 24 to April 25, 1998.
2. Participants in this seminar are college Physics teachers, general college Physics teachers who are not Physics majors, high school Physics and elementary Science teachers from private and state universities and colleges and other professionals who are interested to enrich/continue their own liberal education.
3. The seminar aims to update, upgrade and broaden the Physics background of teachers and to update them on the connection between Physics and various environmental issues. Titles of the weekly seminars including the specific topics to be discussed are in the inclosure.
4. Interested teachers other than the twenty identified participants who shall be sponsored by Funds for Assistance to Private Education (FAPE) shall pay a seminar fee of five hundred pesos (P500.00) for every session. Seminar fee and other expenses incident to the seminar shall be charged against local funds subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
