THE PHILIPPINE LIBRARIANS ASSOCIATION, INC. (PLAI) CONFERENCE  
ON LIBRARIANSHIP IN THE SECOND MILLENNIUM

To: Regional Directors

1. The Philippine Librarians Association, Inc. (PLAI) will hold a conference at the Asian Institute of Management (AIM) Conference Center, Legaspi Village, Makati City on May 13-15, 1998.
2. The theme of the conference is "Philippine Libraries and Librarianship in the Second Millennium: A Centennial Celebration." It aims to: a) identify/select events in the history of Philippine libraries and librarianship that have influenced the present roles of today's libraries and librarians; b) explore the future roles that will shape tomorrow's libraries and librarianship in the Philippines; and c) gain an understanding of the issues and concerns on the emerging education environment for the survival of libraries in the third millennium.
3. Participants to this workshop are librarians from both public and private elementary and secondary schools. Participants from private institutions shall make financial arrangements with their respective schools. Those coming from government/public schools may attend the conference at the discretion of their respective regional directors/schools superintendents.
4. A registration fee of two thousand seven hundred pesos (P2,700.00) will be charged each participant to cover 2 snacks and lunches for three days, seminar kit, honoraria of speakers and other operating expenses.
