NATIONAL WORKSHOP FOR SECONDARY  
TEACHERS OF THE DEAF

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Schools Superintendents

1. Christoffel Blindenmission (CBM) in partnership with the International Deaf Education Association (IDEA) and the Department of Education, Culture and Sports will conduct a workshop for high school teachers of the deaf. This will be held at the Garden Café in Jagna, Bohol on May 17-24, 1998.
2. The workshop aims to follow-up last year's summer training in Davao City on Inclusive Deaf Education with focus on the following topics and activities:
  - a. audiometry;
  - b. guidance and counselling services for high school deaf students;
  - c. development of a 5-year program plan (curriculum) for deaf secondary students; and
  - d. re-training teachers in sign language and interpreting.
3. The participants are the high school teachers who completed the 1997 Davao initial training (list inclosed) and other interested teachers in high schools including private special schools with integrated deaf students.
4. Transportation expenses of bonafide participants shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. CBM will underwrite expenses for the registration fee, training materials and meals. IDEA will provide the accommodation at Pension House of Garden Café. Expenses incident to the attendance of the other participants shall be charged against their own local funds.
