"RIZAL TRAVELLING MUSEUM"

- 1. In celebration of the centenary of the Philippine Independence, the Negros Navigation Company in cooperation with the National Centennial Commission and University of the Philippines (USP), Cebu City launches a tie-up project dubbed as "Rizal Travelling Museum."
- 2. The project aims to provide opportunity for students and teachers to view for free the personal artifacts and collections of Dr. Jose Rizal which were personally donated by his sister Dona Natividad; and to bring history closer to the hearts of the Filipinos particularly to the youth of the nation.
- 3. The Negros Navigation (NN) being the first transportation sector to become member of the Philippine Centennial Movement (PCM) will be giving NN Centennial Cards or travel discount cards to all PCM members which entitle them for a 10% discount on vessel fares. Senior citizens, cardholders, students, and balikbayans who will be joining the centennial celebration shall be given an additional of 5% discount in addition to their regular discounts.
- 4. All regional directors are enjoined to encourage teachers and students to visit the Rizal Travelling Museum as part of their centennial tour activity.
