

CORRIGENDUM TO DECS MEMORANDUM NO. 124, S. 1998

To: Undersecretaries
Assistant Secretaries
Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
School Superintendents

1. The new title shall be **CENTENNIAL EDUCATORS CONGRESS**
2. Paragraph 1 shall read as follows: "The Centennial Educators Congress" will be held at Teachers Camp, Baguio City on May 25-27, 1998 with the theme "Every Filipino Can Be A Hero".
3. Paragraph 3 of DECS Memo No. 124, s. 1998 shall read as follows: "This years Congress will accommodate 650 participants only. At the Central Office, authorized to attend are the undersecretaries, assistant secretaries, bureau directors and their assistants as well as 2 representatives each from SHNC, NETRC, NEAP, EDPITAF, Technical Services and Center for Student and Co-curricular Affairs; and 1 representative each from IMC, GSD, Cash, Medical, Records, Personnel, Accounting, Auditing, Budget, Property, Library, HRD, ICEP, OCA, PEP, CET and Director Max Aljibe. The regional director is given the option to determine who will make up the 32-man delegation from the region but it is suggested to include the regional director **OR** asst. regional director, schools division superintendents **OR** assistant superintendents, regional division chiefs, and heads of private elementary/secondary schools. Other participants are 16 parents from the National Federation of PTCAs, 10 PAES officials, 25 PESPA officials, 25 PASSA officials and 2 officials each from the National Elementary and the National Secondary School Paper Advisers Associations.
4. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned is desired.
