**INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON POPULATION
AND ENVIRONMENT EDUCATION**

**To: Undersecretaries/Assistant Secretaries
Bureau Directors
Regional Directors

Directors of Services/Centers and Heads of Units
Private Elementary and Secondary School Principals**

1. The Department of Education, Culture and Sports (DECS) through the Population Education Association of the Philippines, Inc. (POPED-AP) together with the United Nations Educational Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) and the United Nations Environmental Program (UNEP) will hold the International Conference on Population and Environment Education Towards Sustainable Development on December 8-10, 1998 at the Pryce Hotel, Cagayan de Oro City with the theme "*Challenges of Population and Environment Education for A Sustainable Future*".

2. The Conference aims to:

- identify emerging world issues to be addressed in the 21st century on population and environment education within the sustainable development framework ;
- gain insights on regional/country/institutional/project level experiences in the integration of population and environment education in formal and nonformal education settings;
- discuss strategies and approaches for advocacy, social mobility and promotion of an integrated population and environment education program;
- establish an international network of population and environment education advocates; and
- formulate a declaration of commitment for the integration of population and environment education in all curricula.

3. Authorized to attend the International Conference are:

- Undersecretaries and Asst. Secretaries
- Bureau Directors, Asst. Bureau Directors, Chiefs of Division and their Staff
- Regional Directors, Asst. Regional Directors, Chiefs of Division and their Staff
- Directors of Services, Centers, Heads of Units and their Staff
- Schools Superintendents, Asst. Schools Superintendents, Division Supervisors
- Public and Private School Administrators, Department heads and teachers who can be given substitutes, and school nurses
- Officers of local PTAs
- Officers and members of duly-recognized professional organizations

- PopEd Coordinators (Regional, Divisional, School) and Information Documentation Officers (IDOs)
- Members of the PopEd Association of the Philippines (POPEDAP), Inc.
- Members of the Environment Education Network of the Philippines (EENP)

Delegates from other agencies both local and international shall be authorized by their respective heads of office and their expenses charged against their respective agency funds.

4. A special Conference fee of THREE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED (P 3,700.00) PESOS will be charged to cover registrations, board, lodging, materials, kit and other conference requirements. All delegates are encouraged to stay at the venue. Hotel accommodations will be available from December 7 (afternoon) until December 10 (evening).

5. All expenses (conference fee, and transportation) of delegates and committee members are chargeable against school, divisional, regional and other local funds subject to availability of funds and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

6. Pre-registration with payment (by region, by division, office or agency) is required. Inclosed is the form for this purpose. This form, together with the full payment of conference fees should be submitted on or before September 15, 1998 to the Regional POPED Coordinators (see attached list of PopEd Coordinators) who in turn will forward these by September 30 to:

7. Regional and divisional PopEd coordinators are urged to consolidate and facilitate submission of pre-registration forms with payment from their respective areas.

8. Full cooperation of all concerned and wide dissemination of this Memorandum are desired.
