NATIONAL SEMINAR ON INTERACTIVE TEACHING OF LITERATURE IN BILINGUAL CONTEXT

To: Bureau Directors Regional Directors Schools Superintendents Private Elementary and Secondary School Principals Chairman, CHED

- The Department of Linguistics, Bilingual Education and Literature, Graduate 1. College and the English Department, College of Arts and Sciences of the Philippine Normal University (PNU) in cooperation with the Department of Education, Culture and Sports, and the Commission on Higher Education will hold a national seminar on the teaching of literature in bilingual context, on July 6-8, 1998 at PNU. The theme of the seminar is "Interactive Teaching of Literature in this Age of Information and Technology."
- 2. The seminar aims to acquaint the participants with the strategies on Interactive Teaching of Literature in Bilingual Context through lectures and actual class demonstrations.
- Participants in this seminar are Filipino/English supervisors at the regional and 3. division levels, Heads of English and Filipino Departments, and teachers of all levels in private and government institutions.
- 4. A registration fee of two thousand pesos (P2,000.00) shall be charged each participant for the conference kit, 3 lunches and 6 snacks and certificates of participation and attendance. Transportation, per diems and other allowable expenses of participants from government institutions shall be charged against local funds subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
