The Manila Studies Association, Inc., with the National Commission for Culture and the Arts-Committee on Historical Research, the Philippine National Historical Society, and the National Historical Institute, will hold its Tenth Annual Conference at the Bulwagang Leandro Locsin, NCCA Building, 633 General Luna Street, Intramuros, Manila on June 18-19, 1998.
