COMMEMORATIVE CONFERENCE ON THE MALOLOS CONGRESS

To: Bureau/Cultural Agency Directors Regional Directors School Superintendents

- 1. The Samahang Pangkasaysayan ng Bulakan (SAMPAKA), an organization in Bulacan composed of history professors, teachers, students, and professionals, will sponsor a three-day conference on September 13-15, 1998 at the Bulacan State University and the Barasoain Church in Bulacan.
- 2. The conference which will commemorate the centennial of the opening of the Malolos Congress aims to:
 - a. Recount the significance of the Malolos Congress in the centennial celebration of Philippine Independence;
 - Generate new materials such as modules for teachers' use on how to make the teaching of history an interesting subject for their students;
 - c. Relate how the heroic values of the generation of 1896-98 could be imbibed and applied in nation building by future leaders and citizens;
 - d. Showcase the culture and history of Bulacan through cultural presentations/reenactments during the conference.
- 3. The participants in this conference are professors of history, supervisors, department heads, and teachers of social studies and/or related subjects in public and private elementary and secondary schools as well as other school officials or individuals interested in the promotion of historical and nationalist consciousness.
- 4. A registration fee of Two Thousand Pesos (P2,000.00) inclusive of meals and dormitory lodging during the conference, abstracts of conference papers and Certificate shall be charged each participant. The participants shall join the parade and re-enactment of the opening of the Malolos Congress. They are therefore requested to bring native costumes/Filipiniana dress.
