

PHILIPPINE CENTENNIAL SERVICE CAMP

TO : Undersecretaries

1. As a show of the Scouting Movement's continuous support to the various celebrations of the centennial of the Declaration of Philippine Independence, a Centennial Service Camp is being organized by the Boy Scouts of the Philippines with the full support of the Department of Education, Culture and Sports and at the request of the National Centennial Commission. The Camp will be held in Manila, particularly at strategic locations surrounding the Luneta on June 10 - 14, 1998.
2. About 10,000 delegates from 103 local councils throughout the country are expected to attend the Service Camp.
3. Considering the significance of the knowledge and values that can be imbibed in this event and the importance of the participation of scouts and scouters in extending community service, all regional directors and schools superintendents are enjoined to organize delegations and solicit support from the private sector, local government units and local school boards for this purpose.
4. All Scouts and Scouters attending the Service Camp shall be on official business and excused from their classes for the entire duration of the activity.

5. The DECS Center for Students and Co-Curricular Affairs, through its Executive Officer, Mr. Joey G. Pelaez, is designated as Coordinator of the Service Camp for the Department. For further information and proper coordination, please get in touch with the Center through telephone numbers 631-8495 or 636-3603.
6. Enclosed is the BSP National Office Memorandum No. 19 for your ready reference.
7. It is desired that the contents of this Memorandum be given preferential attention.

Subject : **CENTENNIAL SERVICE CAMP**

1. We are pleased to inform the field that the Boy Scouts of the Philippines, in cooperation with the Philippine Centennial Commission and with the full support of the Department of Education, Culture and Sports and other government and non-government agencies, will hold the Centennial Service Camp at strategic places surrounding the Luneta on 10 - 14 June 1998.
2. Expected to attend this camp are about 10,000 Scouts and Scouters from the National Capital Region and nearby Local Councils. Nevertheless, distant Local Councils are likewise highly encouraged to take the rare opportunity to actively participate in this once-in-a-life-time event as part of our contribution to the celebration of the 100th year of Philippine independence.
3. Qualification for participation are as follows:
 - 3.1. Scouts
 - currently registered Boy/Senior/Rover Scouts;
 - must be a holder of at least the 2nd class rank; and,
 - must be physically fit as certified by a physician.
 - 3.2. Scouters
 - must be duly registered Unit Leader;
 - physically fit and of good moral character.
4. Contingents will bring their own cooking and camping gear (shelter/equipment). The use of tent is highly recommended/encouraged.
5. Likewise, all contingents are advised to bring their own costume for the cultural presentation and/or centennial service camp fiesta.

6. Contingents must arrange for and handle their own transportation requirements from their respective places of origin to the National Office, Manila and back.
7. Let us once again demonstrate our fervent love of our mother land even more than what we have done in the Philippine Centennial Scout Jamboree which was considered one of the biggest and most successful Scouts gathering in the world. Let us continue to prove our sincerity in fulfilling the mission of the BSP and the goals and objectives of our programs and projects, all focused towards the full development of every Filipino Scout.
8. A registration fee of One Hundred Fifty Pesos (Php150.00) shall be charged each participant to cover cost of souvenir items, program and administrative expenses and other component needs.
9. It would be highly appreciated if you could fill up the enclosed Reply Slip and send the same to the National Office together with the payment on or before 30 May 1998.
10. We expect the full cooperation of all concerned for the success of this special activity.
