CENTENNIAL CAMPUS JOURNALISM AWARDS

- 1. The Department of Education, Culture and Sports (DECS) thru the International Cooperation Education Program (ICEP) and the Office on Culture and Arts (OCA), will award the Ten Best Centennial School Papers, English and Filipino, in celebration of the Philippine Centennial on June 12, 1998.
- 2. The awarding rites will be held at the Bulwagan ng Karunungan of DECS Central Office on June 29, 1998 at 9:00 a.m.
- 3. The selection of the Ten Best Centennial School Papers aims to: a) enhance awareness on the significance of the Philippine Centennial; b) recognize the role of the school papers as catalysts of change; and c) raise the quality and standards of campus journalism by giving recognition to outstanding school papers in the country.
- 4. The Centennial Campus Journalism Awards will concentrate on all campus papers in English and Filipino in both public and private elementary and secondary schools in the country.
- 5. The awards will be based on the total number of points accumulated in the Group Contests of the National Schools Press Conference (NSPC) for the last 15 years. Contests include the ten best elementary and secondary school papers, English and Filipino. The 10 pioneering school papers will also be awarded.
- 6. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned is expected.
