

**NEW M. A., MAJOR IN ENGLISH LANGUAGE AND LITERATURE
TEACHING (ELLT) OF THE ATENEO DE MANILA UNIVERSITY**

To : Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Chairman, CHED

1. The Department of English of the Ateneo de Manila University is offering a new M.A. degree, major in English Language and Literature Teaching (ELLT) beginning June 1998.
2. The new degree was created as a response to a growing concern over the perceived deterioration of English language competence in the country. It is designed for graduate students who are secondary and tertiary level teachers and whose main concern is to equip themselves with knowledge and skills in the areas of language and literature teaching. To achieve this, the Ateneo de Manila University is offering two programs, namely Option I: Thesis program, and Option II: Non-Thesis program.
3. The Ateneo de Manila University also offers a 50% discount on tuition fees for certified teachers who wish to enrol in this program.
4. Interested parties may apply for admission to the Graduate School of Arts and Sciences by first taking the entrance examinations scheduled every semester. Application forms are available at the Office of the Assistant Dean for Graduate School, Ateneo de Manila University, Loyola Heights, Quezon City.
