22nd NATIONAL MILO MARATHON

1. The 22nd Milo Marathon this year is scheduled from June to December. The program has produced Filipino long distance runners who have been representing the country in major international competitions.
2. The Department of Education, Culture and Sports (DECS), through the Bureau of Physical Education, and School Sports (BPESS) encourages all school officials to support and send student-participants to the above-mentioned project.
3. The National Milo Marathon consisting of 3K Mini-Marathon for kids 10 years and below; the 5K Family Fun Run which will be held in conjunction with the regular 10 Kilometer elimination race in eleven (11) cities nationwide; and the 42.195 K National Race in Metro Manila.
4. Runners for the 3K Mini-Marathon must submit a photocopy of their Birth Certificate and a written consent from their parents/guardians.
5. A registration fee for each participant shall be collected by Milo's organizers in the following category:

3 K Mini-Marathon - P30.00


