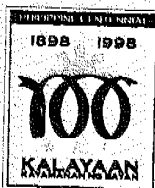
**DECS MEMORANDUM**

**NATIONAL VOCATIONAL EDUCATORS CONGRESS**

1. The Philippine Association of Vocational Education (PAVE), in collaboration with the Department of Education, Culture and Sports (DECS) will hold the National Vocational Educators Congress on October 20-22, 1998 at Teachers Camp, Baguio City. The theme of the Congress is *“Technical-Vocational Excellence: A Challenge to the Next Millennium.”*
2. The impetus of this year's activity will be on the positive outlook of vocational education in the 21st Century. The theme shall focus on capability build-up assistance to Technical-Vocational institutions, programs of livelihood and entrepreneurship, success stories on linkaging, compensations, policy directions and pressing issues and concerns of vocational education.
3. The participants to the Congress are vocational school administrators/principals, presidents and officers of the Philippine Association for Vocational Education (PAVE) regional organizations, presidents of PAVE School Chapters, one (1) active member for every 50 bonafide chapter members, school heads of TESDA supervised technical-vocational schools with secondary program, heads of SUCs, secondary technical-vocational units. Invited to attend are superintendents/heads of schools supervised by CHED with organized PAVE school chapters and heads of private vocational-technical institutions interested in the promotion of vocational education.

3. A registration fee of three thousand two hundred pesos (P3,200.00) shall be charged each participant to cover conference materials, board and lodging, and other incidental expenses chargeable against local school/office funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Meals shall be served from the supper of the 19<sup>th</sup> until breakfast of the 23<sup>rd</sup> of October 1998. Members of the different committees, as well as the present PAVE officials and board of directors, are authorized to travel two days before the Congress. Registration will be on October 19, 1998. Those coming from private institutions shall make financial arrangements with their respective schools/offices.
