SEMINAR-WORKSHOP ON CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION

To: Regional Directors  
Schools Superintendents

1. Child Abuse has become a major concern of Philippine society. It has to be addressed by proper agencies to alleviate the present situation and forestall its occurrence. Our children have the right to be protected.
2. In this connection, the Bureau of Elementary Education (BEE), Department of Education, Culture and Sports will hold a Seminar-Workshop on Child Abuse Prevention on August 10-21, 1998. The seminar will be held at the Regional Educational Learning Center, Cepeda Street, Concepcion, Marikina.
3. The seminar aims to give teachers orientation on the psychosocial manifestations of sexually abused children and some preventive measures and to prepare instructional materials.
4. Each region is requested to send four (4) participants to compose the regional training team, one (1) Division Supervisor and three Guidance Counselors/Teachers. All participants should be writers.
5. Transportation expenses will be charged against local funds subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Board and lodging shall be charged against Preschool Funds.
6. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned is desired.
