CULTURAL PLANNERS ASSOCIATION OF THE PHILIPPINES (CPAP)
CONVENTION - WORKSHOP

CPAP Officers, Board of Directors, and Members

1. The Cultural Planners Association of the Philippines (CPAP), a non-governmental organization of cultural workers and managers, will hold a 3-day Conference and Workshop to coincide with the Association's 9th Biennial Convention on August 7-9, 1998 at the Shariff Kabunsuan Cultural Center, Cotabato City, with its theme: "Preserving the Centennial Spirit."
2. The objective of the Conference - Workshop is to pursue a diversity of cultural development schemes for the preservation, promotion and enrichment of Filipino and cultural heritage, especially during the Centennial Year.
3. In view of the educational significance of the activity, this Office encourages the participation of the CPAP Board Members and Regional Directors and other regional and district supervisors of history, arts and culture, and other cultural officers on official business/travel.
4. A seminar fee of One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P1,500.00) for live-out participants and Two Thousand Pesos (P 2,000.00) for live-in participants to cover food, board and lodging, kits and materials shall be paid by each participant upon registration; and other expenses relative to the attendance in the said seminar, like transportation shall be charged against local funds, subject to the availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
5. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is enjoined.
