**FIRST STAFF DEVELOPMENT SEMINAR OF THE
DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, CULTURE AND SPORTS
MEDICAL OFFICERS ASSOCIATION (DECSMOA)**

1. The Department of Education, Culture and Sports Medical Officers Association (DECSMOA) in cooperation with the Health and Nutrition Center, this Department, will hold its First Staff Development Seminar on October 4, 1998 at the Benitez Hall, Senior Mess Hall, Teachers' Camp, Baguio City. The theme of this Year's seminar is "*DECS Medical Officers: Facing A New Challenge*".
2. The objectives of the seminar are:
 - a) to provide updates on the thrusts and challenges of the Integrated School Health and Nutrition Program (SHNP);
 - b) to present strategic options for the effective delivery of basic health and nutrition services;
 - c) to discuss concerns relative to managing the SHNP;
 - d) to bring together the school medical officers of the DECS so that it will work as one moving and working a common goal in the delivery of Health Services to the school population.
3. The seminar is in line with the provision of RA 499 re: The Continuing Professional Education required by the Professional Regulations Commission.
4. The participants to this seminar are the HNC Medical Officers and Medical Officers from the public and private schools at all levels.

5. Transportation and other expenses of the participants incident to their attendance to the seminar, including a registration fee of eight hundred pesos (P800.00) for board and lodging, snacks, kits, certificates and other incidental expenses shall be charged from local funds subject to its availability and to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Participants from private schools shall make arrangements with their respective schools.
