1998 NATIONAL SUPER QUIZ BEE

To: Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Private Elementary and Secondary School Principals

1. In line with the Philippine Centennial Celebrations, the Quiz Bee Foundation in coordination with the Department of Education, Culture and Sports and other government agencies shall hold the 19th National Super Quiz Bee from July 26 to November 28, 1998.
2. The Super Quiz Bee aims to:
 - a. promote value formation, academic excellence, love of country, peace, brotherhood and unity; and
 - b. enhance learning experiences in science and technology, history, culture, mathematics, general information and international affairs.
3. Elementary and high school students enrolled in both public and private schools are encouraged to participate in this contest. Contest guidelines, rules and regulations are in Inclosures Nos.1, 2 and 3.
4. There shall be one (1) national champion per category, i.e. Senior and Junior levels except in elementary level which shall have two (2) national champions. The contest, including the elimination rounds shall be held after class hours to avoid disruption of classes.
5. Expenses incident to this contest in all levels shall be charged to the Quiz Bee Foundation. For more details, contact Mr. Rasty M. Tayag, Chair of the Quiz Bee Foundation at tel. no. 722-64-01 and telefax no. 735-12-72.

GUIDELINES AS TO LEVEL AND CATEGORY, PRIZES, NATIONWIDE ELIMINATIONS

A. Levels and Subject Categories

I - National Senior Quiz Bee Tertiary Level 18-22 years old	General Information and International Affairs
II - National Junior Quiz Bee Secondary Level 14-17 years old	Science and Technology
III - National Children's Quiz Bee Elementary Level 13 years old and below	Philippine History and Culture Mathematics

B. Prizes

The National Champions shall receive the following:

 - One (1) complete set of Collier's Encyclopedia

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE NATIONAL CHILDREN'S QUIZ BEE
(Philippine History and Culture; Mathematics Category)

Philippine History and Culture

1. All contestants will answer the same sets of questions in writing. Before a question is read, the contestants will raise their pencils or pens.
2. Questions will be read twice by the quizmaster; once in English and once in Filipino. After the second reading, the quizmaster will say "go" -only then will the contestants be allowed to write their answer. Automatically, the 10 second time limit will begin with the word "go" by the quizmaster.

Mathematics

3. Questions will be written in English and read twice by the quizmaster. The contestants will answer each question for twenty (20) seconds which will start when the quizmaster says "go". Continuation of rules for both Philippine History and Culture; Mathematics.
4. After the time limit and buzzer sounds, the contestants will automatically stop writing and raise their pencils and pens.
5. The contestants will be asked to read aloud their answers with the proctors verifying their answers.
6. The National Super Quiz Bee will utilize the point system in all of the competitions.
7. There are four (4) rounds in each competition namely: Easy, Average, Difficult and Clincher
Note: The Clincher round takes place only if there is a tie.
8. In the Easy round, two (2) questions will be asked; in the Average round, three (3) questions; in the Difficult round five (5) questions and in the Clincher round, as many

questions.

9. Points are assigned for each question:

Easy question	1 point
Average question	2 points
Difficult question	3 points
Clincher question	5 points

10. After the fifth question in the Difficult round, the total number of points of each contestant is tabulated.
11. The contestant who gets the highest number of points is automatically declared the Champion; the second highest the Runner-up.
12. Should there be a tie among the contestants getting the highest score or the second highest score, the contest continues to the clincher round to determine the Champion or the Runner-up as the case may be.
13. The total number of points of the tied contestants are now back to zero (0).
14. In the clincher round, as many questions will be asked. Each question is assigned five (5) points. The contestant who first gets fifteen (15) points is declared the winner.
15. Should another tie occur after the third clincher question, one more question will be asked to break the tie and so on until the winner is declared.
16. In case the champion is unable to compete in the next contest level (district, division, region, national), the duly certified runner-up will take his/her place.
17. The duly registered coach of the contestant is the only person authorized to make a protest. All protests should be referred to the judges immediately, that is, before the quizmaster reads the new question.
18. Only the teacher-coach will act as the official chaperon of the contestant to the National Grand Finals.
19. The Board of Judges shall be in complete control of the contest. Their decision shall be final in all questions.
20. Collier's Encyclopedia is the Official Reference of the National Super Quiz Bee. Question formulators may however use other supplementary materials.
21. Any Department of Education, Culture and Sports personnel related by affinity or consanguinity (up to the third degree)

to any contestant shall be disqualified in the committees involved in the planning and formulation of questions in the Quiz Bee nor can they act as coach of any contestant.

22. Past champions and teacher-coaches of the National, ASEAN and World Quiz Bee are no longer qualified to join in future Quiz Bee competitions to give others a chance to aspire for the top honors.
23. The National Quiz Bee Champions are automatically barred to join similar contests for a period of one year.
24. Legal action shall be taken against any organization or person utilizing the "Quiz Bee" name and/or logo without the formal approval of the Quiz Bee Foundation. The "Quiz Bee" was coined and copyrighted in 1976. It is also the registered business name.
25. Any violation of the Quiz Bee House Rules and aforementioned rules shall result in forfeiture of titles, prizes, and privileges of any winning contestant concerned.

**RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE NATIONAL JUNIOR QUIZ BEE
(Science and Technology)**

1. All contestants will answer the same sets of questions in writing. Before a question is read, the contestants will raise their pencils or pens.
2. Questions will be read twice in English by the quizmaster. After the second reading, the quizmaster will say "go" - only then will the contestants be allowed to write their answer. Automatically, the 10 second time limit will begin with the word "go" by the quizmaster.
3. After the time limit and buzzer sounds, the contestant will automatically stop writing and raise their pencils or pens.
4. The contestants will be asked to read aloud their answers with the proctors verifying their answers.
5. The National Super Quiz Bee will utilize the point system in all of the competitions.
6. There are four (4) rounds in each competition namely : Easy, Average, Difficult and Clincher
Note: The Clincher round takes place only if there is a tie.
7. In the Easy round, two (2) questions will be asked ; Average round, three (3) questions, in the Difficult round, five (5) questions and in the Clincher round as many questions.
8. Points are assigned for each question :

Easy question	1 point
Average question	2 points
Difficult question	3 points
Clincher question	5 points
9. After the fifth question in the difficult round, the total number of points of each contestant is tabulated.
10. The contestant who gets the highest number of points is automatically declared the Champion ; the second highest - the Runner-up.
11. Should there be a tie among the contestants getting the highest score or the second highest score, the contest continues to the Clincher round to determine the Champion or the Runner-up as the case may be.
12. The total number of points of the tied contestants are now back to zero (0).
13. In the clincher round, as many questions will be asked. Each question is assigned five (5) points. The contestant who first gets fifteen (15) points is declared the winner.
14. Should another tie occur after the third Clincher question, one more question will be asked to break the tie and so on until the winner is declared.

15. In case the champion is unable to compete in the next contest level (district, division, region, national), the duly certified runner-up will take his/her place.
16. The duly registered coach of the contestant is the only person authorized to make a protest. All protests should be referred to the judges immediately, that is, before the quizmaster reads the new question. No protest will be entertained by the Board of Judges after the quizmaster reads the new question.
17. Only the teacher-coach will act as the official chaperon of the contest to the National Grand Finals.
18. The Board of Judges shall be in complete control of the contest. Their decision shall be final in all questions.
19. Collier's Encyclopedia is the Official Reference of the National Super Quiz Bee. Question formulators may however use other supplementary materials.
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21. Past champions and teacher-coaches of the National, ASEAN and World Quiz Bee are no longer qualified to join in future Quiz Bee competitions to give others a chance to aspire for the top honors.
22. The National Junior Quiz Bee Champion is automatically barred to join similar contests for a period of one year.
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
