ENCOURAGING PARTICIPATION OF SCHOOLS IN THE "OUR PLACE" PROJECT OF OZ GREEN

- 1. Global Rivers Environmental Education Network (Australia) Inc. also known as Oz GREEN invites Philippine elementary and secondary schools to participate in "Our Place" project. The project uses the Internet, fax or mail to link schools and communities/countries to each other and to people near major river systems throughout the world. It enables students from over 135 countries to explore each other's lifestyles and environmental problems to achieve a greater understanding of the global nature of current environmental issues and the part they will play for the needed solution.
- 2. During the course of the project, "Our Place" participants
 - undertake investigations of their local environment;
 - share this information with other groups via the Internet, fax or mail;
 - learn about the environment, culture and lifestyle of participating groups; and
 - share ideas about how to manage environmental problems.
