1. The Philippine Association of Nutrition (PAN) and the Philippine Society of Nutritionist-Dietitians (PSND) will be holding a joint annual convention at the EDSA Plaza, Shangri-la Hotel, Mandaluyong City on August 17-18, 1998 with the theme "Making Food Fortification Work Better".
2. This year's convention aims to identify strategies which will further improve program implementation drawing from both local and international experts' experiences.
3. Participants to this gathering are school nutritionists/dietitians, information officers, supervisors and those interested employees in related profession.
