**DECS MEMORANDUM**

**27<sup>TH</sup> ANNUAL CONVENTION AND SEMINAR-WORKSHOP OF THE  
COUNCIL OF DEANS AND HEADS OF HOME ECONOMICS  
OF THE PHILIPPINES**

1. The Council of Deans and Heads of Home Economics of the Philippines (CODHHEP) will hold its 27<sup>th</sup> Annual Convention and Seminar-Workshop on October 18-20, 1998 at Batis, Aramin, Lucban, Quezon.
2. This 3-day seminar-workshop shall focus on the following objectives:
  - a. Get a clear picture of what the Filipino family will be in the 3<sup>rd</sup> millennium;
  - b. Identify the challenges facing the Filipino family, and
  - c. Equip the Home Economics with the skills and technique for coping with the problems facing the family in the 3<sup>rd</sup> millennium.
3. The theme of the seminar-workshop is "Restructuring Home Economics for the 3<sup>rd</sup> Millennium". Participants in this seminar are deans' associates/department heads and faculty members/teachers of public and private schools offering Home Economics, nonformal education divisions of DECS central and regional offices, staff of the Commission on Higher Education and home economists in Home Economics related fields.

4. A registration fee of Two Thousand five Hundred Pesos (P2,500.00) will be charged to cover the board and lodging, conference materials and other incidental expenses. Transportation, per diems, registration fee and other expenses of participants from government agencies are chargeable against local funds, subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Participants from private institutions shall make their own financial arrangements with their respective schools.

5. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned is desired.
