IMPLEMENTING THE NATIONAL FEEDING PROGRAM

To: Undersecretaries
Assistant Secretaries
Bureau Directors
Directors of Services/Centers and Heads of Units
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents

1. The "National Feeding Program" (NFP) will be implemented in 77 targetted public elementary schools covering 30,800 grade 1 pupils during the school year 1998-1999. This program is focused on the health and nutritional development of the learners so that they will become physically and mentally fit for learning.
2. The NFP aims to:
 - a) improve the nutritional status of school entrants through the provision of supplemental foods such as: fresh milk/fortified snack foods;
 - b) help develop the local dairy industry by creating demand for and generating supply of fresh milk; and
 - c) improve awareness on good nutrition and benefits of milk consumption among school entrants and their parents through nutrition teaching and distribution of information materials.
3. Weighing scales will be provided to the participating schools for nutrition surveillance which will be conducted periodically to monitor the nutritional status of the target beneficiaries.
4. All Regional Directors and Superintendents in the target areas shall extend full support to the operationalization of the program. School health and nutrition personnel are expected to take the lead in the orientation of the school administrators, teachers and parents on the program; and to conduct the nutritional assessment, deworming and weighing of the children. A quarterly report on the program shall be submitted to the Health and Nutrition Center, DECS.
5. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

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
