**PROJECT RESCUE INITIATIVES FOR SCIENCE EDUCATION (RISE)
IMPLEMENTATION OF SECOND BATCH OF TRAINING PROGRAMS**

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors

1. The Department of Science and Technology (DOST) through the Science Education Institute (SEI) in collaboration with the Department of Education, Culture and Sports (DECS) through the Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE), the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) and the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA) announces the implementation of the teacher training program of Project: RISE for the second batch of trainees within the month of September.

2. The objective of the project is to improve/enhance the competence/capabilities of science and mathematics teachers in the secondary level to enable them to teach more effectively and efficiently.

3. Participants in these training programs are teachers of General Science and Mathematics I and II. Priority shall be given to those who are non-majors but are teaching the subjects. Arrangements must be made so that substitute teachers can take over the classes of teachers who will be sent for training. An honorarium of One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00) a week or a total of Four Thousand Pesos (P4,000.00) shall be provided to substitute teachers for the entire duration of the training.

4. The participants will be provided free training fee, stipend of Six Thousand Pesos (P6,000.00) for the duration of the training, book allowance of One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P1,500.00) and the actual transportation allowance (only once) in going to the training venue and back.

5. The training programs shall be conducted in training centers identified by the Regional Technical Committees (RTCs). A network within the region shall be organized involving DOST Regional Offices, DECS Regional Offices (DECSROs) the Regional Science Teaching Centers (RSTCs), CHED, Centers of Excellence (Centrexes), Teacher Education Institutes (TEIs), Engineering Science Education Program (ESEP) tertiary schools in cooperation with the DECS Division Leader Schools. Details about the training program shall be provided by the training institution of the region.

6. Travel and incidental expenses, stipend, book allowance of participants and honoraria for substitute teachers shall be borne by the Department of Science and Technology, Science Education Institute (DOST-SEI).

7. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
