40<sup>TH</sup> ANNUAL NATIONAL CONVENTION OF CMLI JUNIOR MEMBERS AND TEACHER-ADVISERS

- 1. The Children's Museum and Library, Inc. (CMLI), announces the conduct of its 40th Annual National Convention of Junior Members and Teacher-Advisers at Teachers' Camp, Baguio City from October 25 to 30, 1998.
- 2. The Convention with the theme "Kabayanihan: Likas sa Ating Kabataan Noon at Ngayon" aims to increase the awareness of the youth on certain socio-economic developments in their communities and in other places. Activities will include workshops/commission discussions and group dynamic sessions featuring modules on leadership-training, values formation, interpersonal relation and communication. Contests to showcase individual talents and collective endeavors, sportsfest and socials will also be conducted.
- 3. Authorized to participate in the convention are bona fide and outstanding high school students from both public and private schools nationwide. He/She must satisfy at least one of the following requirements: a member of the honor roll, an officer of the school council, an editor of the school paper or head of any school or community-based organization.
- 4. A conference fee of Three Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty Pesos (P3,850.00) will be charged each student-participant and each teacher-delegate to cover expenses for board and lodging, conference materials, souvenir program and other training expenses. Transportation allowance of participants may be charged against school funds or the sponsoring agencies/organizations.
- 5. Student-delegates will undergo make-up classes to cover lessons missed for one week. Schedule of activities and the conference guidelines are enclosed. Those interested must make their reservations on or before October 9, 1998 at the CMLI Secretariat, Unit 7 Fersal Condo. II, 130 Kalayaan Avc., Diliman Quezon City with telephone nos. 924-23-04 (telefax) and 924-22-97.
- 6. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned is desired.

### GUIDELINES

### Eligibility

The conference is open to students of public and private secondary schools nationwide. Schools are advised to send their top students consisting of student council officers, school paper editors, members of the honor roll and officers of their school organizations. Aside from leadership and academic qualifications, each delegate must be of good moral character and in good physical health.

### Conference Fee

The conference fee for this five-day activity is (P 3,850.00) for each student and teacher delegate. This fee is inclusive of board and lodging, conference materials, souvenir program and other training expenses. Transportation expenses to and from the conference site is NOT included.

### Deadline

Those interested must make their reservations either by phone, facsimile or by coming personally to the CMLI Secretariat located at Unit 7, Fersal Condominium II, 130 Kalayaan Avenue, Diliman, Quezon City with telephone nos. 924-2304 (FAXPhone) and 924-2297 two to three weeks before convention proper. A reservation is honored only upon payment of non-refundable deposit of, at least

fifty percent (50%) of the conference fee each person. The balance must be paid during the registration on October 25, 1998.

## Accommodations for the Convention

The Teachers' Camp shall provide complete beddings including one blanket and one pillow per person. Delegates are allowed to bring additional blankets and pillow if they wish.

### Attire

Delegates are required to wear centennial attire during the opening and closing ceremonies. Since sports activities will be held, appropriate attire is desired. Please bring enough warm clothing considering the cool weather of Baguio City.

### Junior Council Elections

Those interested to run for the Junior Council National Executive Board and Regional Executive Board should bring a letter of permission from their parents. This letter should indicate that the student is allowed by his/her parents to undertake the responsibilities of an officer for a year term until the next Annual Baguio Convention. This shall include regular attendance of meetings which are once or twice in two weeks, and all activities of the CMLI.

### LIST OF ACTIVITIES

- OPENING CERMONIES: The Baguio Convention will not be complete without the formal
  opening ceremonies which is usually graced by prominent figures as keynote speakers. In connection
  with this year's centennial celebration, the delegates and their teacher-advisers are required to wear
  their centennial attire. (Filipiniana)
- DULAWISAY '98 (Dula, Awit, Sayaw '98): A talent variety show among participating schools shall be held. Interested school delegations must prepare before hand since no time will be given for rehearsals. CMLI reserves the right to screen performers. Group performances are given a maximum of eight (8) minutes. No more individual performances
- COMPETITIONS FOR EXCELLENCE: The convention shall have the following contests: essay writing contest, timpalak dagliang sanaysay, extemporaneous public speaking, timpalak dagliang talumpatian, poem writing and delivery contest, timpalak dagliang pagsusulat at pagtutula, sculphire making and on-the-spot poster making contest. Participants are allowed to join only one contest. Contestauts for the poster making should bring their own art materials. Competitions for excellence will be done by commission/block. Only one delegate per commission is allowed to participate in each contest.
- SYMPOSIA: Part of the week-long activity is a symposium which focuses on the theme: "MGA
  BAYANI NG MAKABAGONG PANAHON". Experts on the topic shall speak on issues relevant to
  the theme. Through the symposium, the delegates can be informed about certain issues that are relevant
  to many and to the nation as whole.
  - \*Another symposium shall be held with a purpose of promoting social awareness among the delegates. Prominent national figures are invited to speak on certain issues concerning the youth of today. The participants of the convention are given the chance to speak up their thoughts and feelings regarding the topic through open forum.
- FILM SHOWING: During the conference, we will be featuring a film entitled "MINSAN LANG SILANG MAGING BATA". This film focuses on the present situation of child labor and poverty in the Philippines.
- SPORTSFEST (Laro ng Lahi): Stressing friendly competition, teamwork, physical fitness, the
  delegates get to show off their skills and sportsmanship during this inter-block activity.
- WORKSHOPS: Several workshops shall be staged featuring renowned speakers on topics raging from the Arts to Community Development.
- CMLIEXHIBIT OF HEROES: During the convention, the delegates will have the chance to
  se and appreciate the works of our heroes through the CMLI exhibit of heroes. The exhibit showcases
  the various works of our heroes as to instill in the minds of the delegates the richness if Filipino culture.
- CMLIEXHIBIT: The Baguio Convention will also hold an exhibit about CMLI. The said exhibit shall feature the artistic works of many talented youth, a collection of crafts and artifacts from around the country, as well as educational materials and memorabilias of famous Filipinos. I aims to provide basic information of what CMLI is all about. Also, it will enable the delegates to know more about CMLI's history and background.
- CMLI DEBATE FINALS: After a series of heated arguments during the previous rounds
  the much awaited CMLI 5<sup>th</sup> Inter-Secondary School Debate Tournament will be one of the highlights of
  the Baguio Convention. The finalist, coming from all over the country, will showcase their talents in
  speaking up their ideas and views. Though these, they're able to practice critical thinking and logical
  reasoning at the same time. So, may the best debaters win.
- THE JUNIOR COUNCIL ELECTIONS: The brightest students and young leaders from participating schools who aspires to be part of the Junior Council will be given the chance to show their best through the Junior Council Screening and Elections. All the applicants will be screened in order to determine who are really the best. They will be the ones who will continue the idealism of CMLI. From them will be the next batch of the Junior Council National and Regional Executive Boards.
  - DISCO SOCIALS: After a week-long activities during the conference, it's time for the delegates to unwind. The delegates are treated to a night of fun and enjoyment. The Disco Socials will allow right after the Closing Ceremonies.
