ADDENDUM TO DECS MEMORANDUM NO. 229, s. 1998 on the ORIENTATION PROGRAM FOR PRINCIPALS ON HUMAN RIGHTS EDUCATION (HRE) AND LAUNCHING OF THE HRE TEACHING EXEMPLARS

- 1. In relation to the on-going implementation of the Orientation Program for Principals on Human Rights Education and Launching of the HRE Teaching Exemplars, the Staff Development Division and the National Educators Academy of the Philippines, in coordination with the Commission on Human Rights will conduct the same program for selected principals in Region IX and ARMM on September 29-30, 1998 in Atilano Pension House, Zamboanga City.
- 2. The participants will be provided with working knowledge on human rights concepts and principles and the strategies adopted in the teaching exemplars which they will use in conducting briefings/orientation prior to the actual use of the exemplars in classrooms.
- 3. Each division is expected to send 6 participants who are principals or officers-incharge in secondary and elementary schools. They are requested to report to the venue in the afternoon of September 28 for registration and initial activities. - 4. Travel expenses and per diem of participants are chargeable against local funds while travel expenses and per diem of central office facilitators and staff, honoraria of external resource persons and facilitators, supplies and other incidental expenses are chargeable against HRDS Special Programs. Board and lodging shall be provided by the Commission on Human Rights. All expenses are subject to the usual accounting rules and regulations.
