CONGRESS ON THE NATIONAL EDUCATION TECHNOLOGY PLAN

1. The Information Technology Foundation of the Philippines (ITFP) with the support of the New Educational Technologies (NET) Foundation and the Philippine State Universities and Colleges Computer Education Systems Society (PSUCCESS) in collaboration with this Department, the Department of Science and Technology (DOST), the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) and the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA), will conduct a one-day activity entitled, "Congress on the National Education Technology Plan," at the SGV Hall., ACCEED Conference Center, AIM, Pasco de Roxas, Makati City on September 25, 1998.
2. The Congress with the theme, "The Role of Technology in Reforming our Teaching and Learning Infrastructure," aims to improve the accessibility and quality of education through the use of information technology and other innovative education technologies. Specifically, the Congress will address the following concerns: 1) Advocacy and Promotions; 2) Human Resource Development; 3) Infrastructure and Technical Support; 4) Industry-Academe Partnership; 5) Technology Access and Development; and 6) Monitoring and Evaluation.
3. Authorized to attend are undersecretaries, assistant secretaries, regional directors/assistant regional directors, bureau, service and center directors, presidents of PASS, PESPA, PASSA, schools superintendents. Public elementary and high schools with existing educational computing programs may send two representatives each.
4. A conference fee of One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P1,500.00) will be charged each participant to cover the costs of meals and snacks, attendance at all plenary and concurrent sessions, conference materials including, the proceedings.
5. Transportation and other allowable expenses of participants from DECS and government schools shall be charged against local/office funds subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Participants from private institutions shall make arrangements with their respective schools/offices.
