



## THIRD NATIONAL TEACHER TRAINING CONVENTION

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents

- 1. The Books for the Barrios, Inc. (BftB) USA, in cooperation with Books for the Barangay Foundation, Inc. (BBFI) with the financial support from civic organizations and private corporations, will conduct the BftB Third National Teacher Training Convention from June 25 to July 7, 1999 at the ECOTECH Center, Lahug, Cebu City.
- 2. The objective of this Convention is to provide public school educators with a state-of-the-art training program designed to meet the specific needs of DECS elementary schools. This program will consist of seminars conducted by ten volunteer American mentors in advanced instructional strategies based on the Thinking, Meaning-Centered Curriculum paradigm.
- 3. Participants will be barrio elementary teachers, supervisors/principals preferably those without previous training. They shall be selected on the basis of their ability to conduct echo training in their respective provinces. Each Regional Director is allowed to send not more than 12 educators, consisting of ten (10) classroom teachers and two (2) supervisors/principals from each division within their region. Participants will be provided with handouts/materials.
- 4. The convention is broken down into eight days, with four separate sessions, two days each session. The first three sessions will be attended by barrio elementary teachers and the last session will be attended by the principals/supervisors. Inclosed is the schedule of the sessions.
- 5. The Regional Directors are advised to send the list of their participants to DECSRO VII Regional Director, Dr. Eladio Dioko, the convention host. Details of accommodations will be announced in a separate Memorandum.
- 6. Attendance in this convention shall be considered on official business. School heads are therefore advised to make arrangements for substitution work to avoid disruption of affected classes.

- 7. Board and lodging of participants will be provided free by DECS-NCR. Other expenses such as transportation must be raised through local school board or institutional funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures.
- 8. Wide and immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
