**ANNOUNCING THE 1999 SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY
SCHOLARSHIP EXAMINATION**

**To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
District Supervisors
Vocational High School Principals**

1. In support of the poverty alleviation thrust of the government, the Department of Science and Technology (DOST) through the Science Education Institute (SEI) in collaboration with the Department of Education, Culture and Sports (DECS) announces the 1999 Undergraduate Science and Technology Scholarships. The Scholarship Examination shall be administered in eighty (80) test centers throughout the country on November 8, 1998.
2. Students qualified to take the scholarship examination are graduating students of School Year 1998-1999 or high school graduates who have not yet earned any units in any post-secondary or undergraduate course and wish to enter college in School Year 1999-2000. They must belong to the upper 5% of the graduating class, in good health and must have good moral character. Requirements should be duly certified by concerned authorities.
3. Applications should be filed on or before October 15, 1998 for processing at the Department of Science and Technology-Science Education Institute (DOST-SEI), Third Floor, PLEB Bldg., Muntin, Taguig, Metro Manila, DOST Regional Offices and Provincial Science and Technology Centers nearest the applicants' school or home addresses.
4. Application forms are available in the aforementioned offices/centers. They can also be obtained from DECS Regional Offices and Offices of Congressmen/Municipal Mayors.
5. For further details regarding the scholarship examination, refer to the inclosed DOST-SEI Undergraduate Scholarships and the Science and Technology Scholarships (RA 7687).
