COMMEMORATIVE CONFERENCE ON THE FIRST PHILIPPINE REPUBLIC

TO
Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Division Superintendents
Heads of Private and Public Secondary Schools

1 The Samahang Pangkasaysayan ng Bulakan (SAMPAKA) an organization in Bulacan composed of history professors, teachers, students and professionals and the DECS Division of Bulacan will sponsor a three day conference from January 21-23, 1999 at the University of Regina Carmel and the Barasoain Church in Bulacan.

2 Entitled the Commemorative Conference on the First Philippine Republic, the activity aims to

a. Raise public consciousness on the significance of the First Philippine Republic

a. Provide a forum for student leaders to articulate their knowledge of leadership principles as enunciated by national heroes such as Mabini, Rizal and Bonifacio and

c. Develop modules for use by history and social studies teachers touching on the most recent findings in historical research and perspectives

3 The participants in this conference are at least 350 high school student leaders and their chaperons, particularly those who participated in the Centennial Youth Leadership Program (CYLP) held last April 1998 and other individuals interested in the promotion of historical and nationalist consciousness.

4 At least two (2) student delegates from each province shall be selected by the DECS Division of Schools on the basis of their leadership qualities and knowledge of history, particularly those of their respective provinces and of the Revolutionary Period. The chaperons must be teachers of history, not more than 45 years old and with basic history degree such as MAT, MA or AB in history to ensure that they can participate fruitfully in the discussions and workshops. Only one teacher chaperon per region shall be allowed.

5 A registration fee of Two Thousand Pesos (P 2 000 00) inclusive of meals and dormitory lodging during the conference abstract of conference papers and certificated shall be charged each participant Transportation and other expenses relative to attendance in the conference of teacher chaperons only shall be charged against local funds subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations

6 In the case of public high school teachers arrangements shall be made for substitutes to be paid from any available lump sum funds for the purpose On the other hand participants from private schools shall make financial arrangements with their respective institutions

7 All participants shall join the parade and re enactment of the opening of the First Philippine Republic on the last day of the conference They are therefore requested to bring native costumes/Filipiniana attire
