REACTIVATION OF THE SCIENCE CLUB ADVISERS ASSOCIATION OF THE PHILIPPINES (SCAAP)

TO

Regional Directors Schools Superintendent District Supervisors

- 1. In line with our goal to enhance science education and as a significant part of our co-curricular activities, the Department of Education, Culture and Sports (DECS) is pleased to announce the reactivation of the Science Club Advisers Association of the Philippines, Inc., otherwise known as the SCAAP.
- 2. The SCAAP is an educational, scientific, non-stock, non-profit, non-political and non-sectarian organization supportive of the goals of the DECS. It aims, among others, to do the following:
 - promote and strengthen science consciousness among its members and among our people through science clubbing activities;
 - formulate guidelines and coordinate activities and efforts on the research process and other scientific activities for all affiliated chapters;
 - c. coordinate with the DECS and link with other agencies in the advancement of science and technology;
 - d. provide opportunities for the professional advancement and continue exchange of ideas among its members;
 - e. enhance cooperation and harmonious relationship among its members throughout the country;
 - f. provide leadership in organizing clubs and assist those already in existence; and
 - g. give due recognition to outstanding achievements of its members.
- 3. As part of its reactivation, the SCAAP has reconstituted its Constitution and By-Laws and elected its Board of Directors and officers of the National Executive Council, the list of which is attached herewith.
- 4. In view of this, all interested science club advisers are encouraged to join the SCAAP, and organize and strengthen its regional and division councils nationwide.
