FESTIVAL OF ASIAN CHILDREN'S ART CONTEST WINNERS

1. The Mitsubishi - Impression Gallery Festival of Asian Children's Art Contest sponsored by the National Federation of UNESCO Associations in Japan in cooperation with UNESCO National Commission Philippines and the Department of Education, Culture and Sports held last July-October 1998, yielded a total of One Thousand Ninety-Three (1,093) entries from all over the country.
2. The National Screening Committee selected ten (10) winning entries which were sent to Japan last October 1998 for final screening by the International Screening Committee who will select the final winners. The winners will be announced at a later date by the International Executive Committee in Japan.
3. One Grand Prix winner will be selected and invited to an all-expense-paid trip to Japan with one guardian to attend the awards ceremony on a date to be announced later. Two (2) Excellence Award winners will be selected and will receive special gifts while the last seven (7) winners will receive the Mitsubishi Public Affairs Committee Awards.


