## 1999 NATIONAL CONFERENCE ON THE GIFTED

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Private Elementary and Secondary School Principals

1. The Department of Education, Culture and Sports through the Special Education Division of the Bureau of Elementary Education, in collaboration with Gifted Philippines, Inc. (GPI) will sponsor the 1999 National Conference on the Gifted. This sixth national conference will be held at the UP-ISMED, Diliman, Quezon City on May 17-19, 1999 as its contribution towards the Centennial of Philippine Independence. The theme of the conference is "Ang Henyo, Ang Matalino at ang Malikhain: Isang Sentenaryo, Bagong Milenyo".

## 2. The conference aims to:

a. highlight the role of the gifted in appreciation of his roots and in response to the challenges of the next millennium;

b. set new directions in the education of the gifted Filipino in the next century;

- c. update educators, parents, other professionals, community workers and all those concerned on issues, trends and thrusts, programs and services in the education of the gifted; and
- d. advocate for the welfare, development and nurturance of the gifted as well as the actualization of his gifts for the benefit of the country.
- 3. Special education teachers, school administrators with special education programs, supervisors in charge of special education from the regional and sub-regional levels from public and private schools are expected to attend.
- 4. A registration fee of Two Thousand Pesos (P2,000.00) shall be charged every participant. This will cover expenses for snacks, lunches and conference materials including certificates and handouts.
- 5. Major publications on the gifted will be given free to the first one hundred fifty (150) participants who will register for the conference.
- Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
